50% Secwépemc Language Immersion

Since 2010, the TteS started the 50% Secwépemc Language Immersion Program – the children spend half the day learning and using the Secwépemc Language. Our language teacher uses a variety of teaching strategies. Through experiential activities, the children are given an opportunity to hear and learn the language as much as possible.

The immersion program is based on child-centered curriculum based on a wide variety of themes and topics. Components of the program include:

- Daily Routines (greetings, eating, cleaning up, bathroom, going outside, etc.)
- Morning Circle
- Language Lessons/Total Physical Response
- Daily Story Time (traditional & modern)
- Outdoor Play
- Nature Walks/Structured Play
- Action Songs & Games
- Secwépemc Song and Dance
