Trans Mountain has committed to collecting native seed for use in Lac du Bois Grasslands Protected Area (LdB) following construction of the Trans Mountain Expansion Pipeline Project (TMEP). Seed will be collected from species that are key components of the native plant communities and rare plant communities in LdB. Collections will occur at a number of sites throughout the Thompson River Valley so the natural genetic variability of the plant species is retained.

The program will be conducted by the Tk'emlups te Secwepemc with the help of a local field supervisor and an assistant field supervisor.

## **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Field Crew Lead will have some experience leading crews and an interest in native plants and restoration. This position will receive instruction in the identification of local plant species, particularly grasses, site selection for seed collections, monitoring seed readiness, seed drying and seed cleaning techniques

- Experience as a crew lead punctual and reliable and works well with others.
- Able to direct a crew, is a positive example for crew members in regard to safety and work ethic.
- Can keep records, such as filling out forms required for the program, crew work hours, safety forms etc. and providing these forms in a timely manner to the program manager.
- Able to work alone as they will be required to monitor the collected seed on their own (go to the storage facility and shake the seed bags, make sure there are no rodents.
- Check to make sure climate conditions at the facility are as prescribed; is a problem solver would be of benefit.
- Must have valid First Aid certificate.
- Valid Class 5 Driver's license.
- Physically able to work out doors throughout the summer. Conditions will include hot, dry open areas, possibly in steep terrain, remote access areas.

**HOURS OF WORK:** Non – normal shift may be required.

Field hours 8-10 hour shifts as seed ripens (not every day, it will be as seed is located and ripens to collect).

**PAY GRADE:** As per current salary grid.
