- Utilize knowledge of and keep informed of various tax acts to ensure taxes are paid correctly and applications for tax refunds and self-assessments are made promptly and accurately;
- Explore opportunities for tax savings within Teck Highland Valley Copper (THVCP) and ensure applicable business areas are informed and reporting correctly;
- Ensure correct application of taxes on purchase orders (PO), warehouse inventory authorization change (IAC), records and vendor invoices; monitors PO's and invoices to ensure appropriate internal cost coding;
- Maintain a library of tax regulations and rulings accessible to end-users; make presentations and company training sessions regarding taxes as they pertain to THVCP;
- Research and/or develop more efficient ways of doing tax reviews;

- Reconcile and monitor payments to meet provincial and federal government deadlines;
