Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc , Sechelt and James Bay Cree are all equal partners in the Certified Day Scholar Class action We have agreed to enter into negotiations with the Government of Canada as a result we asking the bands to identify the following in each nation:

**Day Scholars** (a person who attended a federally owned and operated residential school during the day and returned home every night).

**Descendants:** the children (son or daughter of the day scholar only) natural ,legally adopted or traditionally adopted by ceremony.

**Band class** –a band with a residential school on or near their lands and they must have had day scholars. We require the total amount of your membership.

For your convenience I attached the forms that we require bands to fill out. Please note that these forms are for negotiation purposes only it's **not a formal application for compensation**. Please return the forms back to me No later than **September 30,2016**

**The day scholar forms will be used for our negations data only and are not considered as an application for settlement.**
