PURPOSE OF POSITION:

Reporting to the Public Works Foreman, the Landscaper/General Labourer position takes direction from and reports directly to the Public Works Foreman. The Landscaper/General Labourer position is responsible for general maintenance functions for community infrastructure and facilities and supports Public Works operations. The Landscaper/General Labourer position is expected to operate with the highest level of customer service and safety.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Complete lawn maintenance of the Sports Fields and lawns around Chief Louis Centre, Powwow Grounds, and TteS. Including mow grass, trim/prune trees and hedges, and planting as required.
- Operation of a variety of light and medium duty vehicles and equipment associated with the various activities within the Public Works department.
- Backfill Public Works operations such as:
 - o Waste management duties, e.g. recycling and curbside pick up.
 - o Cutting grass on roadsides
 - o Repairing and installing street signs, etc.
- Perform pre-trip inspection of vehicle systems and equipment such as tires, lights, brakes and fluid levels.
- Report any tools and equipment that are not in good repair.
- Perform safe operating and maintenance practices and procedures related to the equipment with in the TteS Public Works Department.
- Perform mechanical servicing and light repair of equipment.
- Cut grass, rake, fertilize and water lawns, weed flower beds, prune shrubs and trees.
- Perform minor repairs to irrigation lines and sprinkler heads.
- Operate power mowers, tractors, power trimmers, sod cutters and other landscape maintenance equipment.
- Perform responsibilities with varying weather conditions.
- Perform all duties and responsibilities in accordance with the TteS policies, standards and procedures.

- Maintain confidentiality on all matters of the TteS.
- Other related duties as necessary.

QUALIFICATIONS, KNOWLEDGE AND OTHER SKILLS:
