



## **UNB Job Posting**

### **Silviculture Crew Positions**

UNB is preparing to undertake contract silviculture work with multiple clients commencing in late summer or early fall 2019.

Work will be field based with a minor amount of administration time attributed to the field crew supervisor position noted below.

The UNB Natural Resources Office is looking for trained, capable and willing chainsaw and brush saw operators to fill out a daily crew of 5 people to undertake work at the mine site. We will also be hiring 1-2 alternate "on call" personnel for days that regular crew members may be unable to work. Position preference will be for UNB Members first and then hiring will open to the general public.

This work will be available through a temporary employment contract only. It is anticipated that the work should be consistent throughout the fall and winter at 5 days per week. Equipment and PPE will be provided. Certain work reporting and safety conditions apply which will be highlighted in the temporary employment agreement.
