## LITTLE FAWN NURSERY FEE SCHEDULE

### Preschool Program

From September to June (as each school year begins and ends), Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc Member's children and other First Nations children who qualify for the **Nominal Roll** are free of charge.

### Child Care Monthly Fees

Infants (0-18 months)	\$900
Toddler (19-36 months)	\$771
3 to 5 year olds	\$675

Note 2: An enrolment fee of **\$30** is due immediately. This fee is not covered by child care subsidy or nominal roll funding.

Note 3: Parents/Guardians are responsible for all child care subsidy applications and payments.

## High Priority: Secwépemc Language Revitalization

Since 2010, the TteS started the Secwépemc Language Immersion Program – the children spend the day learning and using the Secwépemc Language. Our language teachers use a variety of teaching strategies. Through experiential activities, the children are given an opportunity to hear and learn the language as much as possible.

The immersion program is based on child-centered curriculum based on a wide variety of themes and topics. Components of the program include:

- Daily Routines (greetings, eating, cleaning up, bathroom, going outside, etc.)
- Morning Circle
- Language Lessons/Centres
- Daily Story Time (traditional & modern)
- Outdoor Play
- Nature Walks/Structured Play
- Action Songs & Games
- Traditional Secwépemc Song and Dance
- Secwépemc seasonal round/solstice events
