### PURPOSE OF POSITION:

The Wellness Support Worker will provide supports and wellness services to survivors, and assist with community engagement sessions, as well deliver activities and programs that promotes Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc wellness.

### DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- **ASSIST:** Mental Health and Wellness Manager to coordinate strength-based supports and programing for survivors.
- **RELATIONSHIPS:** build and maintain positive and effective relationships with Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc KIRS Survivors.
- **SURVIVOR SUPPORT:** travel to meet survivors/elders, conduct home visits, attend meetings, network with service providers, and raise awareness of programs and services to Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc KIRS Survivors;
- **DEVELOP:** activities, programs, lunch and learns, gatherings and programs that promote mental health and wellness;
- **CO-FACILITATE:** wellness workshops (youth, women and/or men's, Elders, Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc Survivors) and cultural safety training;
- **RESEARCH:** organizations that have successfully developed healing and wellness programs, services, and partnerships, complete literature review and annotated bibliography;
- **PARTNERSHIPS:** maintain positive working relationships with internal and external personnel and/or organizations/agencies;

- **RESOURCES:** develop resources through the connection of social networks and other social supports, to positive outcomes for Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc survivors and develop a resource booklet;
- **COMMUNICATION:** communicative effectively both orally and in writing, including making presentations to a variety of audiences, ensuring material is adapted as required for the audience.

- Diploma or Degree with specialization in Health Sciences, or Social Services or a related field

**Skills and Abilities:**

- Excellent interpersonal communication skills and ability to work as a team player to effectively interact with other departments and staff
