YOUR ROLE

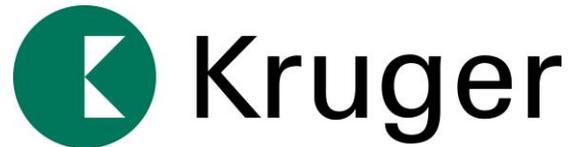
