1. Program Information—What you will do in the program:

The youth employment program begins on Friday, December 1, 2025 and ends on Friday, February 27, 2026, a total of thirteen weeks. Youth will be placed with various projects within respective departments and be mentored by a staff member for the duration of program. Youth will be expected to participate in the various training programs offered to youth throughout the duration of the program. There will be interesting workshops hosted within Tk'emlúps specifically for career, educational and cultural development that Youth are encouraged to participate in, some participation may be mandetory.

2. Program Costs

There will be no cost to participate in the program. However, successful Tk'emlúpsemc Youth applicants will receive a wage of \$20 per hour. Only the youth employees will be paid for their time so they must have a bank account previously set up before starting the program. Youth will be provided PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) by the Education Department Youth employees will be responsible for providing their own rides to and from work. No rides will be given to youth. Also, youth will be responsible for providing their own daily lunch for work.

3. Who should apply

Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc youth aged 15-30 should apply who are <u>not</u> working or in school. There will be 2 highly motivated TteS youth hired. More than anything, we want youth who want to make the most out of this opportunity. The Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc Youth Employment Program is created for our youth who:

- Are committed to exploring educational and employment options
- Have good attendance
- Have a positive attitude and willingness to learn
- Show leadership qualities in some of the following areas: academic studies, effort, attendance, arts and culture, sports, volunteering and participating in various community activities

4. How to apply:

- 1. Read through the whole information package.
- 2. Complete all sections of the application form included with this package. All answers must be in your own printing and written in complete sentences.
- 3. Make sure that upon completion you sign your application form, and that your parent or legal guardian signs as well (if applicable).
- 4. Provide us a copy of your status card.
- 5. RETURN the application form with all documents to the Education Department

Incomplete applications (i.e., applications that do not have complete sentences, applications that are missing signatures, etc) will not be considered. Please make sure to submit your application **with all documents** if you plan on applying. Thanks!

5. Selection
