- Please bring all these necessary documents with you when paying your taxes or submitting your Grant application.
- Any form of payment made (including online) still requires you to submit the TteS FN Grant annually.
- Penalty will be applied to all late submission of Grants & Tax payments on Aug 3rd of the calendar year.
- Have you applied for a Grant elsewhere in BC? If so, you are ineligible for the TteS Grant. You cannot apply for more than one Grant in BC.
- If you submit an address other than the address your tax notice is mailed to, you will be considered ineligible for the TteS FN Grant unless you can provide proof of residence.
- The TteS FN Grant does not apply to arrears, penalties, or delinquent taxes on them.
