STEWARDSHIP RESOURCE TECHNICIAN

Reporting to and under the direction of the Natural Resources Manager, the Stewardship Resource Technician is responsible for assisting and implementing programs related to Fisheries. A minor focus of the job will be implementing programs related to wildlife, forestry, cumulative effects and water.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintain a positive, professional environment in accordance with Adams Lake Band policies and procedures
- Works with Shuswap Fisheries Commission on implementing and reporting projects.
- Represent ALIB interest at other Fisheries focused tables.
- Fisheries Aquatic/terrestrial habitat and regulatory compliance monitoring.
- Environmental management programming.
- Participate in multi-disciplinary projects and work closely with biologists, hydrologists, ecologists, social scientists, engineers and other project specialists;
- Deliver communal fisheries program.
- Support Community hunts and gatherings
- Fisheries proposal development and reporting
- Sit on various fisheries committees as needed.
- Fisheries Project deliver, such as the Adams Lake Salmon Restoration Project
- Participate in wildlife, forestry, cumulative effects and water tables as directed by the Natural Resource Director
- Supervise Stewardship technicians as required for projects

- A minimum of 2 to 3 years' experience in related field and knowledge and experience in a First Nations environment
- Ability to work weekends or non-normal hours
