Mapped in 1877

• Tk'emlúps

• Area: 32,690 acres

• Usage: Forest, range, industrial, residential

#### **RESERVE NUMBER 2**

Mapped in 1878

Tsyuqwen—Trap Lake (Willow Ranch Area)

• Area: 15 acres

• Usage: Fishing station

#### **RESERVE NUMBER 3**

Mapped in 1878

Q'ilye—Trap Lake

• Area: 7 acres

• Usage: Fishing Station

#### **RESERVE NUMBER 4**

Mapped in 1878

• Cyensqin—McClure Flats area—Gilead—Whispering Pines

Area: 180 acres

• Usage: Timber Reserve

#### **RESERVE NUMBER 5**

Mapped in 1878

• Tkék-Yeel-Stem—Heffley Lake

• Area: 46 acres

• Usage: Hunting and fishing station

### **RESERVE NUMBER 6**

Mapped in 1928

• XecXyúm—Hihum Lake

• Area: 79 acres

• Usage: Fishing station

 Held in common with Bonaparte, Kamloops, Upper Nicola Skeetchestn has a smaller parcel also on the lake
