RESERVE NUMBER 1

Mapped in 1877

- Tk'emlúps
- Area: 32,690 acres
- Usage: Forest, range, industrial, residential

RESERVE NUMBER 2

Mapped in 1878

- Tsyuqwen—Trap Lake (Willow Ranch Area)
- Area: 15 acres
- Usage: Fishing station

RESERVE NUMBER 3

Mapped in 1878

- Q'ilye—Trap Lake
- Area: 7 acres
- Usage: Fishing Station

RESERVE NUMBER 4

Mapped in 1878

- Cyensqin—McClure Flats area—Gilead—Whispering Pines
- Area: 180 acres
- Usage: Timber Reserve

RESERVE NUMBER 5

Mapped in 1878

- Tkék-Yeel-Stem—Heffley Lake
- Area: 46 acres
- Usage: Hunting and fishing station

RESERVE NUMBER 6

Mapped in 1928

- XecXyúm—Hihum Lake
- Area: 79 acres
- Usage: Fishing station
- Held in common with Bonaparte, Kamloops, Upper Nicola Skeetchestn has a smaller parcel also on the lake
