Before submitting your application, please note the following details and requirements:

It is very important that you ensure the child will be comfortable being around the Blazers in their full gear and comfortable being out on the ice in front of a large crowd.

- Please ensure that the skating ability of the child will allow them to participate in this program. They will be asked to skate the full length of the ice, do a lap or tow, go into the huddle with the Blazers, and skate to the blue line and then off the ice onto the bench entirely on their own.
- Child will receive 4 tickets for the game. Additional tickets you need can be purchased through the Blazers Box Office. Tickets can be picked up ahead of time or at game time.
- Child and parents/guardian will be required to arrive at the Sandman Centre 45 minutes prior to game. **Parking will NOT be provided.**
- Child must bring all of their own gear and will be provided with a dressing room to change in and store their gear during the game.
- Child will be provided with a jersey to wear on the ice. Child will also receive a jersey to take home.
- A date will be arranged prior to the game night for the child and a parent/guardian to come in for a “head shot” photo to be taken which will be used on the video screen on game night. At this time, we will also show you around and answer any questions you may have.
- A Blazers photographer will take a photo of the child standing on the blue line with the Blazers starting lineup. This photo, as well as any other shots that are taken, will be passed along in digital format for the family.
- A maximum of two people will be allowed to stand at the gate at the end of the Blazers bench to watch the child come out as well as be there to help them come off the ice. Any other family members will be asked to be in their seats or remain in the hallway/dressing room.
